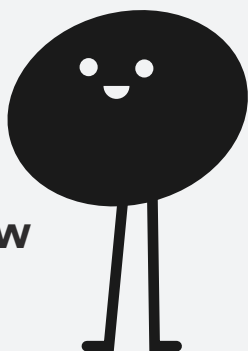


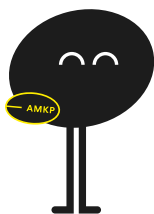

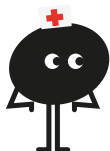


first steps...



Collect your student ID card

The student ID card entitles you to discounts. You can collect it at your Faculty Office after showing the confirmation of payment of PLN 22 to the AMKP bank account: 41 1240 2294 1111 0000 3708 8240.

You can receive a referral from Ms Adriana Chmura (room 3, 6th floor). Do it immediately in order to participate in the classes without any problems.



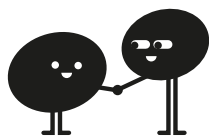
Check your email inbox

At the beginning of the academic year, you will get the account in the amkp.edu.pl domain created. The first access is possible through the NESOS system. Activate your library account

The library is located on the first floor in the Main Building at ul. Świętego Tomasza 43 and consists of 3 departments: reading room (room 121), lending room (room 122), and record library (room 118). If you have been granted a place in the Student Dormitory, make sure to read the accommodation conditions and applicable rules. You will find them on our [website](#).



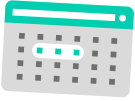
Study Regulations

Krystyna Moszumańska-Nazar Concert Hall

It is located on the ground floor on the right side of the main hall.



Marek Stachowski Chamber Hall

It is located on the ground floor on the left side of the main hall.



Bronisław Rutkowski Florianka Hall

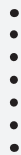
A modern building with a concert hall located next to the Krzysztof Penderecki arboretum in Lusławice.
